SAVE TIME RENEW ONLINE

Avoid line-ups and visit our website yorku.ca/parking to renew your permit online.

Full-time parking garage/reserved permit holders must renew their permits prior to June 30th each year in order to secure a parking space in the reserved lot for the following semester.

ABOUT YOUR PARKING PERMIT

York University parking permits must be visibly displayed from the rear view mirror and all vehicles must be registered with Parking & Transportation Services to avoid citations. Your Parking Permit is valid only for the specific lot assigned and the duration purchased.

A gate access card will be issued with the first permit purchase at no charge and reactivated for future use. Charges for replacement access cards will apply.

SAVE MONEY WITH CARPOOLING

Priority carpool parking spaces are available at ten locations across Keele campus. In order to qualify for a free priority carpool parking permit, your car must be registered in the Diamond Pool Parking program and online at Smart Commute.

Share the cost of a parking permit and gas with the Diamond Pool Program. Offered in all available lots, two or more registered car pool members will receive a complimentary parking package.

LOST/STOLEN PERMITS AND ACCESS CARDS

Lost/stolen parking permits and access cards must be reported immediately to Parking & Transportation Services. A found parking permit or access card must be returned to the Parking & Transportation office. Charges for a replacement permit and access card will apply.

PERMIT REFUND REQUESTS

All requests for parking permit refunds must be made directly to Parking & Transportation Services. A \$15 administrative fee will apply. To obtain a refund for pre-paid or unused parking, your permit must be returned to the Parking & Transportation office no later than the third business day of the month.

CHANGE OF INFORMATION

Permit holders must inform Parking & Transportation Services of any changes in the information provided in their original application. Proper documentation must be provided for any changes.

SAFETY

goSAFE is a complimentary service provided by York University to all members of the York community. If you need to get from one point on campus to another, goSAFE teams will meet you anywhere on campus, such as the Village Shuttle pick-up hub, parking lots, bus stops or residences and walk with you to your on-campus destination. There are a variety of ways to reach the goSAFE office, please visit their website below for additional information.

In an emergency situation you can use any of the Blue Light Emergency Phones located throughout campus and parking lots to be connected with Security Services immediately. York University also has a free mobile safety app that provides one stop access to all of the University's safety resources.
